

URIEL CROSBY

Although no records are found on Fold3, Uriel Crosby is included in the D.A.R. Records as a Virginia Soldier who drew Pension [??]. His wife's name is given as Susanna. Because Uriel died in 1799 and his wife, Susannah Conway Crosby, died in 1806, it would seem very unusual if either husband or wife had been awarded Pensions. It is possible Uriel's Heirs may have applied for Bounty Lands in later years.

Family records state Uriel Crosby married Susannah Conway in Stafford County, Virginia, on January 11, 1764. Uriel and Susannah had many children who are named in the Family Bible Records . Susannah was a daughter of Thomas Conway who died in Virginia and a sister of the Conway brothers who also had served in Virginia Regiments during the Revolution, and who later came to Greene County, Tennessee. Uriel is shown in the Rent Rolls of Stafford County, Virginia in the year 1768. It appears Uriel Crosby was of Huguenot descent:

Uriel Crosby signed his Will on February 15, 1799. The Will was probated in the April 1799 Session Court in Greene County. Named in this Will were wife, Susanna, and children George, Thomas, William, Susanna VanPelt, Frances Murray, Anne Jackson, Sarah Crosby, Elizabeth, Mary, Lydda, Peggy, Nancy, and Jane Crosby. Son, William (1781-1817), would later serve in Captain Kirk's Company in the War of 1812. He is buried in the Conway Cemetery. Executors of Uriel's Will were sons George and Thomas Crosby.

Susannah Conway Crosby died only a few years after her husband. Her Will was signed June 14, 1806. Children named in this Will were Anne Jackson, Lydda Davis, George, Thomas and William, Susannah VanPelt, Frances Murray, Sally Davis, Elizabeth Crosby, Mary Briant/Bryant, Peggy Crosby, Rebeckah Smith, and Nancy and Jane Crosby.

Uriel and Susannah and many family members are buried in the well maintained Crosby Family Cemetery located about two miles south of today's Mohawk, Tennessee:
